

From Our Pastor THE SCOOP ON ADVENT

The angel went to her and said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you." Mary was greatly troubled at his words and wondered what kind of greeting this might be. But the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, you have found favor with God. You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you are to call him Jesus." -- Luke 1:28-31 (TNIV)

The season of Advent is upon us. This is a time when we're called to ready ourselves for the coming of the Christ. It's a time each year when we are invited to make room in our hearts again for Jesus.

It may seem odd or easy to be asked to do that. But pause for a moment and think about it as it applies to your life this past year. Have you pushed Jesus to the outer edges of life, perhaps unintentionally. Or have you've pushed Him out of your life entirely? Are you like the innkeeper who told Mary and Joseph there's no room for Jesus? Do you need to make room for Jesus in your heart again? In the busy-ness of life, it can happen without realizing it. - Christmas Eve, <u>11:00pm</u> service -"Carols and Candle Light"
- Christmas <u>Day</u>, 9:00am service We welcome Jesus!

These are ways at Mohawk Church to make room for Jesus, and there are certainly others. You might sign up to ring the bell for Salvation Army. You could take a shift at a food pantry, help at Love, Inc., serve at a soup kitchen, to name some ways to share the love of Jesus and help others make room for Him.

As we "remember the Reason for the Season" this Advent, may your preparations lead to a deeper, more significant experience of the Birth of Jesus.
