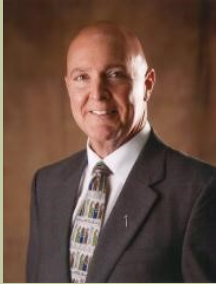

“GUEST” WHAT SEASON IT IS

¹ Keep on loving one another as brothers and sisters. ² Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers, for by so doing some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it. - Hebrews 13:1

Did you know we're in a season within a season?

The season of Lent is also a season for newcomers to check out churches. That means we will probably see folks worshiping with us that we may not know or folks that nobody invited. Isn't that a great opportunity?!?

One of the many reasons I love being pastor at Mohawk Church is that we are a faith community who is receptive to having new people join us in worship. I've often heard it said around here that we are a warm/friendly/welcoming church.

It reminds me about a study that was done a few years ago with hundreds of U.S. congregations. In this particular study, newcomers rated how friendly a congregation was, and members of that congregation also rated themselves on their own friendliness. Do you know what the study found?

Virtually every congregation rated themselves as friendly, even ones that newcomers rated as unfriendly! Why the discrepancy? Newcomers gauged the friendliness toward themselves (newcomers) while members of "unfriendly" congregations only rated their friendliness toward one another to

the exclusion of any newcomers who were there.

Those unfriendly congregations followed verse 1 of Hebrews 13 but not verse 2. They were so preoccupied "loving one another" that they forgot to show hospitality to the strangers in their midst!

Dear friends, let's be sure Mohawk Church follows BOTH verses, especially in this high season of newcomers in church. There's a simple way to make people feel welcome: Don't treat them as *visitors* but as *guests*. Guests are welcomed. Valued. They are expected, and they're expected to come back. Try to make every newcomer your very own guest. Invite the in and invite the back.

We can't ignore newcomers, but we don't have to overwhelm them, either. All you need to do is treat them as your guest. The rest should come more easily.

Being The Church of Jesus Christ means loving one another AND showing hospitality to strangers.

We might welcome angels in that process, but we will certainly be regarded as angels by those newcomers. May we all make it so!
