

Some well-meaning ones told me we need to grow our church. They were surprised when I told them I won't do that. I understand what they want, but that's not the right approach. I've contended for a long time that efforts to "grow our church" will fail and likely backfire.

Think of this scenario: A friend approaches you and says they are part of a great health club, but it's failing.

They are desperate for you to join so you will pay your monthly dues and maybe keep it from closing. Would you join this faltering club or would you run the other way? If it were me, I'd be running!

I believe the right approach is to offer the one thing only The Church can offer - a relationship with Jesus Christ and with people who love Jesus. We can disciple others, help them into a deepening relationship with Jesus and His People, which they need. Doing that also helps us become better disciples, by the way.

We need to take our mission statement, "Making disciples of Jesus Christ," seriously. It's a great and perfectly aimed statement. We can make better disciples of ourselves, which helps us make disciples of people who are hurt, lost, lonely, unchurched, forgotten - all those who need Jesus and His People in their lives.

When we make disciples, our church will grow because it's the power of God at work. If we try to grow the church, we won't. So I say, don't grow my church! Instead, let's make disciples together so Christ's church will grow!
